



WEEKLY UPDATE

March 10, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives:

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Since our last update we have had a few changes. Our outbreak status was closed by the MDH on 2/27/21. However, on 3/4/21 we had a resident who tested positive. Since the resident was low risk for getting the virus, we tested again with a negative result. The lab conducted an investigation which revealed there had been a lab error and the test result was invalid. The resident had another negative test on 3/5/21 and continues to be asymptomatic.

This week, on 3/8 and 3/9, we tested 115 staff members for COVID-19. All of the test results were negative.

We are continuing weekly testing of staff per MDH guidance and CMS recommendation and will continue to test our residents only if they are displaying any signs or symptoms of Covid-19. Per the updated Maryland Department of Health Orders, we are currently reviewing our policies and procedures and will proceed with visitation after training and educating our staff. We are proceeding slowly so as to keep our residents and staff as safe as possible. We will continue with visits for compassionate care situations.

As of today, March 10 our cumulative total for positive COVID-19 cases is 85 residents and 48 staff members.

We also continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing, use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

WEEKLY UPDATE

March 18, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives:

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Since our last update we have had a staff member test positive for Covid 19 who has no symptoms at this time. We have started lab testing the residents again with all of the tests being completed today.

This week, on 3/15 and 3/16, we tested 100 staff members for COVID-19 with 99 negative tests and 1 positive. Today we are beginning to lab test all of the staff members to comply with the guidelines for testing during an outbreak.

We will continue weekly testing of staff per MDH guidance and CMS recommendation and will begin to test our residents weekly and if they are displaying any signs or symptoms of Covid-19. Per the updated Maryland Department of Health Orders, we are currently reviewing our policies and procedures and will proceed with visitation after our outbreak is closed and the staff is educated and trained. We are proceeding slowly so as to keep our residents and staff as safe as possible. We will continue with visits for compassionate care situations.

As of today, March 17 our cumulative total for positive COVID-19 cases is 85 residents and 49 staff members.

We also continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing, use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

WEEKLY UPDATE

March 26, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives:

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Since our last update we have had no new staff members test positive for Covid 19. We continue with weekly testing of staff and residents to comply with the guidelines for testing during an outbreak.

This week, on 3/22 and 3/23, we tested 100 staff members for COVID-19 with 96 negative tests and 4 pending tests. We tested 89 residents on 3/22 with all 89 residents testing negative.

We will continue weekly testing of staff and residents per MDH guidance and CMS recommendation and will continue to test residents weekly and if they are displaying any signs or symptoms of Covid-19. Per the updated Maryland Department of Health Orders, we are currently reviewing our policies and procedures and will proceed with modified visitation until our outbreak is closed by the Maryland health department. We will continue with visits for compassionate care situations.

As of today, March 24 our cumulative total for positive COVID-19 cases is 85 residents and 49 staff members.

We also continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing, use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
