July 1st, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

We are happy to report that we continue to have 0 new cases of COVID-19 amongst our residents or staff. As of today, our totals of positive COVID-19 cases remains unchanged, with 76 residents and 25 staff members having tested positive for COVID-19.

On July 1st and July 2nd, Northampton Manor is completing their second round of facility wide staff testing as required by CMS and the Maryland Department of Health. Residents are not included during this round of mass testing at this time. If a new positive COVID case is identified during the staff testing, then all residents will be tested as a preventative measure. Once the results of the staff testing are received, we will update our website with any new confirmed cases of COVID-19.

Northampton Manor continues to exercise CDC recommendations for all appropriate precautions and preventative measures to protect our residents and staff during this pandemic. In accordance with the guidelines set forth, we are still continuing restrictions on visitation. We realize how difficult it is not to be able to see your loved ones, and we continue to work diligently to meet criteria set forth by the CDC and the Maryland Department of Health in hopes to eventually enter Phase 1 of Reopening of Nursing Homes. As a reminder, we are facilitating virtual visits (via face-time and other video applications). If you would like to schedule a virtual visit with your loved one, please call our Activities Department to schedule a time.

Northampton Manor continues to closely monitor and follow the recommendations of our federal, state and local health officials. Only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Please continue to check our website for updates. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.

WEEKLY UPDATE

July 16th, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

On July 7th and 8th, we completed week 3 of our facility wide testing, including staff and residents. We received the results of these tests on July 14th and 15th, and identified no new positive cases of COVID-19.

On July 13th & 14th, we completed week 4 of our facility wide testing, including staff and residents. We are still receiving results from these tests, but as of now we have identified 1 resident that is positive for COVID-19. All other residents tested negative. 119 staff members were also negative, and we still have 25 results that are pending at this time.

Per direction and guidance set forth by the Maryland Department of Health, we continue to complete testing of all residents, as well as all staff, on a weekly basis.

As of today, July 16th, our cumulative totals for positive COVID-19 cases are 76 residents and 30 staff members having tested positive for COVID-19.

We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility go down and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

As of today, July 23rd, our cumulative totals for positive COVID-19 cases remain unchanged, at 76 residents and 30 staff members having tested positive for COVID-19.

We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility go down and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. July 30th, 2020

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

Since our last update, we received our weekly testing results from 7/20&7/21, have identified 1 new staff case of COVID-19. The staff member who tested positive has been asymptomatic and is recovering at home per CDC guidelines.

We continue each week with facility wide testing of residents and staff per the Maryland Department of Health direction and guidance. This week, on July 27th & July 28th, we tested 97 residents and 151 staff. Results are pending at this time.

As of today, July 30th, our cumulative totals for positive COVID-19 cases are 76 residents and 31 staff members having tested positive for COVID-19.

We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility go down and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

As we see an increase in COVID-19 in our community, we have also been closely monitoring staff travel in line with CDC and Maryland Department of Health guidelines in order to identify any staff member that may need increased monitoring, testing, or to be excluded from work based upon their risk factors for exposure.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as Northampton Manor's weekly update to keep you informed about the status of COVID in our facility and what we are doing to keep our residents and staff safe during the ongoing coronavirus pandemic.

On July 1st and 2nd we completed our 2nd round of facility wide staff testing. We received the results of these tests on July 6th, and as a result we have identified an additional 5 staff members positive for COVID-19. The staff members are currently self-quarantining at home. As a result of discovering new positive cases within our facility, per direction and guidance set forth by the Maryland Department of Health, we are now completing testing of all residents, as well as all staff, on a weekly basis.

As of today, July 9th, our cumulative totals for positive COVID-19 cases are 76 residents and 30 staff members having tested positive for COVID-19.

We are committed to seeing the number of positive cases in our facility go down and we will continue to implement and practice enhanced safety precautions recommended by our federal, state and local health officials, such as, only allowing essential personnel inside the facility, performing regular screenings for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering the building, continually monitoring residents, performing regular deep cleanings, using PPE as recommended by the CDC, providing individual activities as opposed to group activities, implementing isolation protocols as required, and reminding and encouraging staff to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community.
